Health insurance	All incoming European students should have the <b>European Health Insurance Card (EHIC)</b> , which entitles the holder to get necessary treatments at the same cost as an insured person living in the country you are visiting. The card is valid only for state-provided services, as private health is not covered. When accidents occur during the didactic activities in the school locations, students in international mobility are covered by injury and civil liability insurance. We strongly recommend that students ensure they have medical insurance before their arrival and we also highly recommend to provide a liability insurance to cover any accidental damage caused to other people or properties.
