[1] DECREE OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS of 9 April 2001 (in Official Gazette no. 172 of 26 July). – Provisions for uniformity of treatment on the right to university studies, pursuant to Article 4 of Law No. 390 of 2 December 1991.

Article 13 Actions in favour of foreign students from outside the European Union

... 5. For foreign students coming from particularly poor countries, having a low human development index, the list of which is defined annually by a decree of the Minister, issued in agreement with the Minister for Foreign Affairs by 28 February, their financial position is assessed based on a certification issued by the Italian Representation in the country of origin stating that the student does not belong to a family known to have a high income and high social standing. Alternatively, for students enrolled at a university in their country of origin, linked by agreements or conventions with the university of enrolment in Italy, this certification may be issued by the aforementioned university. For students enrolling in the first year of undergraduate and postgraduate degree courses, certification that the student does not belong to a family known to be of high income and high social standing may also be issued by Italian bodies authorised to provide a guarantee of financial coverage as set out in the current provisions on the enrolment of foreign students in Italian universities; in this case, the body issuing such certification undertakes to return the grant on behalf of the student in the event that it is withdrawn in accordance with the procedures set out in Article 6(3). The student is in any case obliged to declare any income and assets held in Italy by their household in the manner set out in Article 5.
